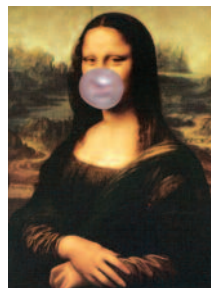

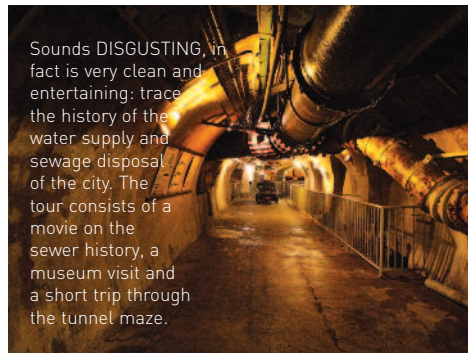

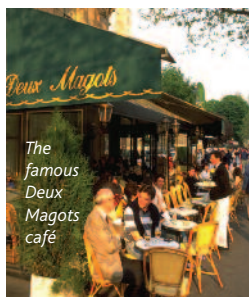
5 THE PARIS SEWERS

The second arrondissement or district is known as the Bourse, (stock exchange) making it Paris' financial centre and it is here that we find L'Horset Opera, just about 5 minutes walk from the Louvre Museum and with the best in luxury shops, both fashion and culinary, close by. The façade of the hotel is classical and elegant and this is echoed inside, with large amounts of wood paneling in the public areas and rooms tastefully decorated to a high standard. 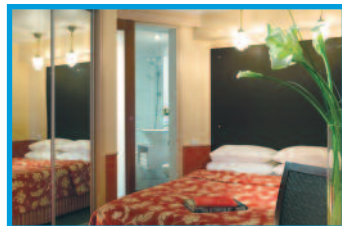


OPÉRA CADET ★★

24, Rue Cadet, P 75009

The Opera Cadet, a superior 3 star hotel, is situated in a charming, typically Parisian side street in the heart of the Opera district of Paris, about a 10-15 minute walk to the Louvre Museum and closer again to Boulevard Hausmann, the street that contains the famous Parisian department stores Printemps and Galeries Lafayette and many others. 81 boulevard Gouvion Saint-Cyr, P75848

The Etoile is strategically located on the Right Bank where the business and fashion districts of Paris meet, close to the Arc de Triomphe and just a few minutes from the world's most famous avenue, the Champs Elysees. The rooms are bright, very modern and stylish and you can enjoy at L'Orenoc restaurant or a drink at the sophisticated Jazz Club Etoile, an institution in Paris for Jazz lovers. Note: restaurant and club are closed on Sundays.

PAX OPERA HOTEL ★★

47, Rue de Trévise, P 75009

The Pax is set in the heart of the Opera district of Paris, about a 10-15 minute walk to the Louvre Museum and closer again to Boulevard Hausmann, the street that contains the famous Parisian department stores Printemps and Galeries Lafayette and many others. The rooms are bright, modern and functional as the hotel specializes in the tourist market and a plentiful buffet breakfast is offered in the 2004-renovated dining room. Concierge service available for all types of reservations and the bar is open 24 hours, though clients should note it is tiny.

HOTEL MODERNE ST. GERMAIN ★★

33 rue des Ecoles, P75005

This hotel is located in the Latin Quarter on the left bank between Saint-Michel and Saint-Germain and very close to Notre Dame. Guests may use the sauna, jacuzzi and fitness centre facilities of the sister hotel next door for a fee.
