RESTAURANTS

Try the delicious vegetable dishes such as escalivada, a salad of roasted aubergine, peppers and onions and for seafood & paella it's hard to go wrong in the Barceloneta fishing district. Wash the lot down with Catalan wine, sparkling cava or a swimming pool of local Estrella beer.


