The Friedrichshain is near the Alexanderplatz in the east side of the city, close to the metro and Frankfurter Allee station but clients should note that train lines run close to the building. The facade and interior have a French brasserie feel to them and the rooms are simply and tastefully decorated. HAMBURG

Europe's second largest port and Germany's wealthiest city, Hamburg welcomes you to a worldly and cosmopolitan place, a hub of media and fashion as well as home to one of Europe's most famous red-light districts. Much of the city was destroyed in the Great Fire of 1842 or in WWII, and in the rebuilding the planners emphasized a rural feel, giving two-thirds over to parks, lakes and tree-lined canals.
